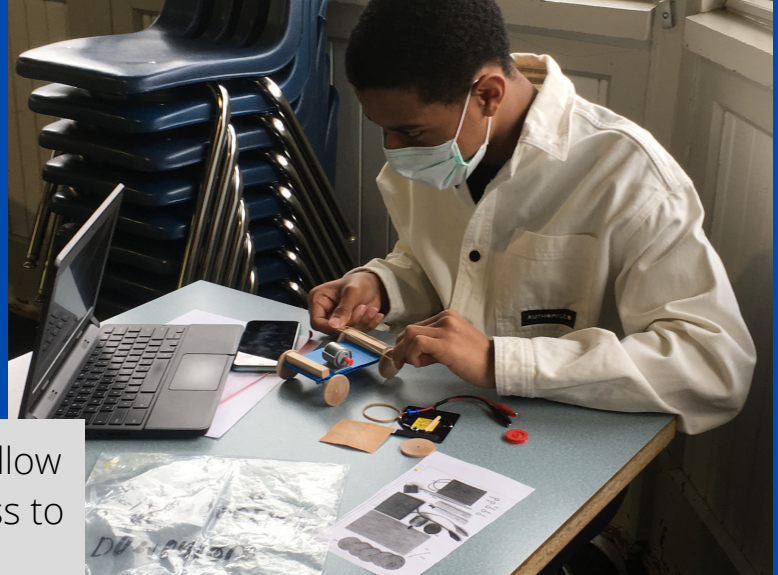




# Tri 3 Classroom Highlights
